DVD CARE TIPS

Most problems encountered with a DVD – the disc not loading, skipping chapters, images freezing and pixilating – are caused by smudges and scratches on the disc's underside, a result of mishandling and improper home cleaning techniques. A few tips to avoid scratching or damaging discs:

◇ **Hold the disc at its edges or through the hole in its center. Never touch the underside with your fingertips.**

◇ **Use a soft cotton cloth to wipe discs, nothing woolen or coarse. Wipe out from the center, not in a circle.**

◇ **Avoid using tap water to clean discs, as it has a higher salt concentrate than bottled or mineral water, and could scratch the disc further.**
